

ORDINANCE 59

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MCKINLEYVILLE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
 AMENDING RULE 23.03 OF MCS D'S RULES AND REGULATIONS
 REGARDING PUBLIC ACCESS STANDARDS

WHEREAS, The Board desires to protect sensitive natural resources and to facilitate development of access to recreation trails designated in a public agency adopted access/trail plan; and

WHEREAS, The current version of Rule 23.03 is too rigid in relation to protection of sensitive natural resources and not always practical in regards to routing of sewer mains;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MCKINLEYVILLE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESCINDS THE SECOND SENTENCE OF RULE 23.03 AND REPLACES IT WITH THE FOLLOWING SENTENCE: "The final subdivision map shall provide for dedication for public trail use of easements and right of ways in which community sewer lines are to be constructed where such use does not significantly threaten a sensitive natural resource and where the access is designated in a public agency adopted access/trail plan."
